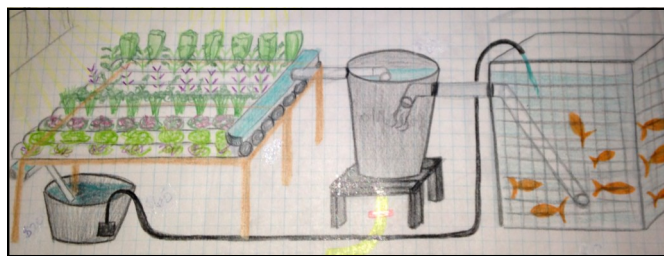

In the mission world, we always look for ways to gain access to people groups. By developing aquaponic systems at the Mission House, we are learning ways to feed the nations both physically and spiritually. Aquaponic systems grow fish and vegetables in a closed-loop system. The vegetables grow twice as fast and only use 10% of the water as traditional farming methods. For villages without a quality water source, conservation is key. This new agricultural technique also brings with it the ability to teach English, science, engineering, technology, and math skills within the villages we reach.

Thailand Outreach — On May 29th-June 11th, Sharon will be leading a team to Wiang Pa Pao in northern Thailand. The team of engineering students will be implementing two aquaponic systems in the village. The fish and vegetables will feed elementary school
